2009 MINNESOTA STATE FAIR HEREFORD SHOWS

The state fair hosted three quality Hereford shows: 4-H, open class and FFA. Each show was won by different animals and as always the fair gave time for breeders to visit.

The 4-H show started the fair with Champion Hereford Heifer exhibited by Lakyn Lind, Rushmore and reserve champion exhibited by Mackenzie Kruse, Cambridge.

The cow/calf honors went to Jaime Hanson of Comfrey. Champion Hereford Steer was exhibited by Nicholas Delaney, Lake Benton and Reserve exhibited by Dana Kuelbs, Grey Eagle.

The 118 head open class show was held the following weekend and was judged by Robert Alden of Hamilton, MO. Bonnie Reed organized an exhibitor's dinner following the show paving the way for a fun afternoon gathering. Many thanks also to Dave Jones, Dave Gottschalk and Kent Heins for running the ring.

Williams Hilltop Polled Herefords, Rochester took home champion heifer with WMS 27 P1635 Miss Catalina 205U sired by Klondike 1635 ET taking grand and March calf RH 230

743 Candice 50W taking reserve champion sired by CRR About Time 743 and owned and exhibited by Jake Rabebl or Rochester. BPH JLB Tyra 3P exhibited by Brown Polled Herefords, Grand Rapids won champion cow/calf. The cow is sired by S&S DRFKJ Cattleman 49H. Grand Champion Bull honors went to KMK Herefords, Grey Eagle with MH Rambo 757 1ET sired by GH Rambo 279R and Reserve Grand Champion Bull went to Schmidt Herefords, Pipestone with SH MR Unity U344A ET sired by SHF Porterhouse M33P52.

Sunday brought the last round of competition with the FFA show. Jason May, Randolph took Champion Heifer honors with Kain Queen 9898 sired by 20N Spartan 103S and also won champion cow/calf with May Hannah sired by Boyd Cowmaker 0112. Reserve Champion Heifer was awarded to Gabe Lind, Rushmore with Lind Ms Miranda 33U sired by DH West Fort 253.

2009 MIDWEST CLASSIC

June 19th, Pipestone

The 2009 Midwest Classic saw a change in dates but no change in the high quality of cattle typically exhibited at the junior show. The show, headed up by Jenna Schmidt and family, featured 33 heifers, a cow/calf pair, two bred and owned bulls and 8 steers. Cattle arrived and checked in on Saturday and exhibitors were invited to Schmidt Herefords for a pizza party and social.

Sunday morning found juniors up preparing for the show and father's competing in the Father's Day obstacle course. It was all hands on deck as the show started with the bred and owned females evaluated by judge Greg Harder. Top bred and owned heifer honors went to Michael Delaney with JSH Ms Unique 412R 75U, a March Obsidian heifer with reserve going to Marty Delaney showing JDH Ms Yankee 11U ET, an February Yankee heifer.

Owned heifers hit the ring for the start of a tough show top to bottom. Abby Repenning came out on top with JH Dominette 0854, an April Grand Slam daughter and reserve honors went to Jason May showing Kain Queen 0808, a February Spartan daughter. Champion Cow/Calf went to Jackson Neil with JF Phantom Lass 06T with her Top Secret bull calf taking reserve champion bull. Champion bull honors went to Jaime Hanson with J&J Milwaukee 3U, a February son of Direct Line.

The steer show was equally difficult. Nick Delaney took champion steer with a Red Felton son followed by Jason May's steer for reserve. **Thank you to Jenna Schmidt and Schmidt Herefords for all of the hard work and hospitality!**
